

Rules & Regulations

- **Check-Out Time:** 1:00 PM
- **Check-In Time:** 2:00 PM
- **Picnic Tables:** One per site, please.
- **Campfires:** One per site. **DEFACING OR DAMAGING TREES AND SHRUBS IS CONSIDERED VANDALISM AND WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE LOSS OF CAMPING PRIVILEGES.**
- **Firearms and Weapons:** The use of firearms, firearms, BB guns, slingshots or other weapons in the resort is prohibited.
- **Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children and you may not leave them unattended.** *Any parent who does not follow these rules is responsible for 100% of the damage.*
- **Anyone caught deliberately destroying or defacing campground property will be expected to pay these damages and will then be asked to leave with no refund.**
- **POOL RULES:** POOL RULES ARE POSTED AT POOL. **POOL USE FOR REGISTERED GUESTS ONLY. CHILDREN UNDER 10 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.** Please swim at your own risk in the pool. Use the buddy system to insure your safety. You must have a towel if swimming in pool. Babies or small children not potty-trained must wear rubber pants in pool. We have them at office for a fee.
- All guests of permanent campers must pay to swim.
- Shoplifters are subject to prosecution and will be evicted without a refund.
- Only boats owned by registered campers are allowed launching at the boat ramp. NO guest boats are allowed to be launched.

- Please keep campsite as clean and neat as possible. Please put garbage bins in a disposal container and not on the ground.
- Parking limited to your lot only.
- No ATVs or go-carts allowed.
- We reserve the right to discharge any campers not abiding by park rules.
- Pets are to be kept on a leash. Please clean up behind your pet. Do not leave your pet unattended at your site.
- Assignment of campsites will be made at the office. Please occupy your site and do not move without first checking with the office.
- We are not liable for theft or injuries occurring during your stay.
- No washing dishes or cooking utensils in the bathroom.
- All motorized vehicles (battery, electric or gas) must be observed from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM in the park.
- All motorized vehicles (battery, electric or gas) must be permitted at office. You must have a valid license or permit.
- No offensive activity shall be carried on in any area of the park or on any leased site. Boisterous or noisy behavior or profanity will not be tolerated. **DRUNKENNESS IS NOT TOLERATED. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MUST BE CONFINED TO YOUR LOT.**
- Trash is to be taken to dumpsters.
